

## **MORLEY HAYES ACCESS STATEMENT**

Set in the picturesque Derbyshire countryside, with beautiful views of the surrounding landscape, Morley Hayes offers luxury hotel accommodation, award-winning dining and state-of-the-art golf facilities.

At Morley Hayes, we are committed to equality of access for all. We believe the attitude of our staff is as important as the physical accessibility of the building and are confident that all our guests have access to our facilities and are made to feel welcome throughout their stay.

### **Arrival and car parking**

There are 231 car parking spaces, 11 of which are designated for disabled guests and are located between 6m and 24m away from the various main entrances.

A drop-off point is located directly outside the main entrance and should be used only for dropping off and picking up of guests.

All guests should use the main entrance of the hotel, which is accessible from the car park. There are no steps and there are automatic doors into the main reception.

The hotel has a wheelchair available on a complementary basis for guests. Please advise the hotel before booking if you require a wheelchair.

Service dogs are welcomed throughout the hotel and grounds.

### **Main Entrance and Reception**

There are no steps in the main reception area, which has seating for guests to wait. The front desk is immediately in front of you when entering through the main reception, with a small bar to the left and a spacious lift to the second floor on the right.

An induction loop is installed at the reception desk and registration cards can be enlarged if required. Staff are on hand to should guests require any further assistance with their registration card.

The whole of the ground floor of Morley Hayes is accessible to wheelchairs, all doorways and corridors are wide and well lit.

## **Bedrooms**

Two ground floor rooms have been purpose-built specifically for wheelchair access. Both rooms have wide doorways, level entry showers in wet rooms, grab rails and low-level furniture. The pillows in these rooms are set to vibrate in the event of a fire alarm to alert hearing impaired.

There are telephones in all rooms and room service is available 24 hours a day.

## **Restaurants**

The Roosters bar and restaurant, which serves traditional home-cooked bar snacks and meals using seasonal ingredients from local suppliers, is situated on the ground floor and can be accessed from the car park.

Low level seating and table service is available and the menu includes diabetic and gluten free dishes. Any dish on the menu can also be adapted to suit any specific needs.

The Dovecote restaurant is situated on the second floor, with access via a ramp.

## **Public Areas – WC**

There are eight sets of public toilets, seven of which have a separate disabled toilet fitted with rails.

## **Leisure Areas**

Morley Hayes is renowned throughout Derbyshire for its golfing facilities, with a 17 bay, all weather driving range, the 9 hole Tower course and the 18 hole, Championship length Manor course.

The Pavilion and Spike Bar can be accessed via a ramp.
